8th Grade Class Trip to Washington, D.C.

- 1. If more than the minimum number of students sign up, will there be a decrease in cost?**

No, the price per student remains the same.

- 2. If the travel company has to cancel the trip due to another covid virus, or company situation, do the parents get their monies returned?**

If Martin Travel cancels the trip then they will refund everyone except the \$100 non refundable deposit. If it's inside 60 days, then they will refund money that vendors return to them. However, if parents purchase the trip protection package then they will receive a full refund minus the trip protection amount. They can cancel up to the night before the trip, they can't cancel the morning of the trip. This can be purchased by them at checkout on the We Travel page.

- 3. What is meant by hotel security?**

The school administrators and chaperones will be checking rooms nightly. The travel company will provide a night guard who will be on duty to monitor the halls and provide a report in the morning. The night guard will alert school administration immediately if an issue arises.

- 4. Do you have a plan to deal with health issues on the trip?**

Each student will have their Emergency Medical Form on file with school staff. School staff will carry student medications and assist in administering the medication. If there is an emergency, the travel agency will help coordinate transportation and aid as needed. Parents will be contacted. If there is a serious medical emergency, parents may need to arrange transportation to and from the Washington, D.C. area for the student and themselves.
