The Board of Education approved the General Fund bills in the amount of \$108,588.33.

The Athletic Fund bills in the amount of \$1,779.56 were approved by the Board.

The Capital Project bill was approved by the Board in the amount of \$14,660.81.

Gary Anderson from the district's auditing firm, Anderson, Tuckey, Bernhardt and Doran presented the 2013-2014 audit to the Board. Revenues came in at \$5,052,778, expenditures come to \$5,139,244, resulting in \$86,466 being taken from fund equity for a fund balance as of June 30, 2014 of \$2,423,936.

The Board approved the purchase of a 2015 Ford F350 4x4 pickup from Tubbs Brothers of Sandusky in the amount of \$25,145.

The Board approved a three day, two night Spanish trip to Chicago on March 20-22, 2014.

The Board approved changes made to the High School Student Handbook reflecting a Personal Curriculum option for students.
