

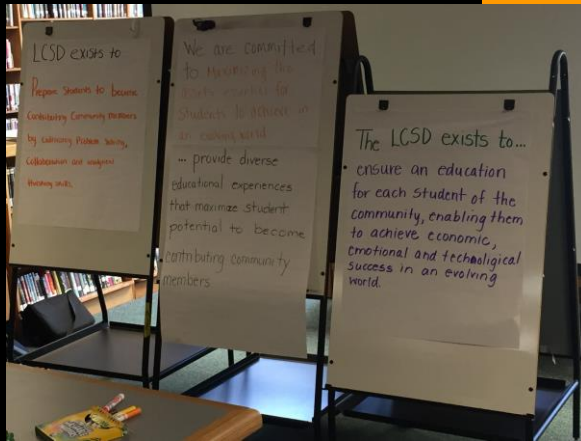

Spring 2018: Committee is established: teachers, staff, administrators, student, and parent representatives

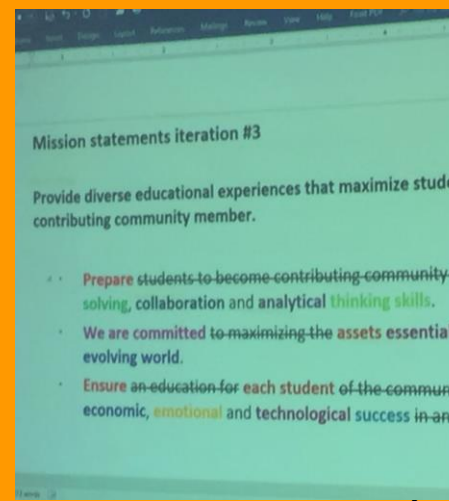
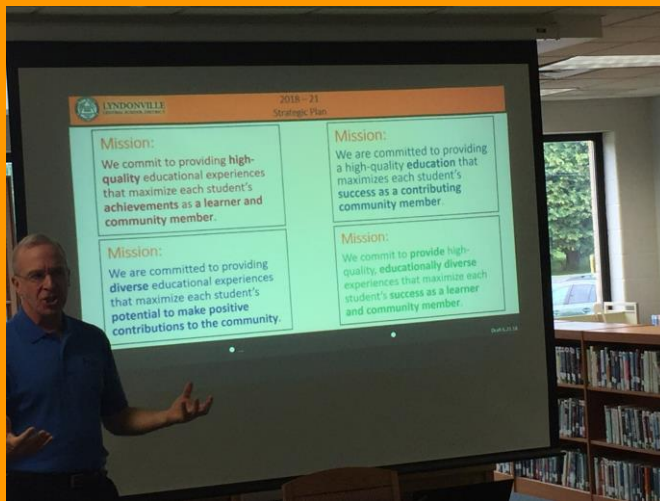
June 26 and 27, 2018: committee meets and objectives are met

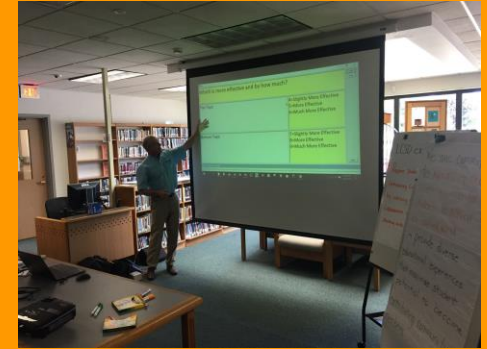
