THINGS TO KNOW:

- Cost of tests (*current costs as of 09/2018*):
 - SAT (no essay): \$47.50 // SAT (with essay): \$64.50 // SAT Subject: \$26
 - www.collegeboard.org
 - ACT (no essay): \$46 // ACT (with essay): \$62.50
 - www.act.org
- If you are enrolled in the Free & Reduced Lunch Program, you get up to 2 test waivers for each test (ACT, SAT & SAT Subject Test). These waivers allow you to test for free. You have to sign up for Free & Reduced Lunch on a YEARLY basis to qualify.
- Make sure to select the schools that will receive your scores **AT TIME OF REGISTRATION** or any time **BEFORE** the test day. You get to use up to 4 codes to send your scores for free.
 - For SAT, send scores to **ALL** CSUs with code 3594
 - For ACT, send scores to **one** CSU and **ALL** CSUs will receive them
 - For both tests, when you send scores to **one** UC, **ALL** UCs in the UC System receive your scores
 - MJC/Columbia College - 4108
 - Merced College - 4500
- Take note to whether universities you are interested in require the essay portion. CSU's recommend the essay portion and UC's require the essay portion. It varies for private schools.
- Items to bring with you on Test Date: Calculator, No. 2 pencils, your admission ticket, and a valid ID. Refer to the Collegeboard and ACT websites for more details on what "valid ID" means, and for which calculators are allowed. On test day, arrive by 7:45am and find your room assignment by checking the rosters.
