Parents and/or Guardians,

The SAEBRS Fastbridge screener is a teacher observation and assessment tool used to identify students who are at risk for social, academic and emotional behaviors in K-12. Students are assessed three times a year based on the frequency of various behaviors observed (Never, Sometimes, Often, Almost Always) in the three domains listed above. MySAEBRS is a student-rater companion assessment, which allows students in grades 2-12 to self-assess their social, academic and emotional behavior.

By evaluating in which of the three specific domains a student is at risk, educators may determine what type of supports are most appropriate and which behaviors should be prioritized through intervention. The use of both screeners provides a more complete picture of a student's social-emotional functioning and well-being. The school uses this data, as well, to determine any school wide programs or activities to meet the greatest academic, social and emotional needs of our student body. Parents are welcome to come to the school to view the questions on the surveys and the results of the survey will be shared at conferences.
