Policy Statement

This policy is intended to act as a guide in ensuring that all curriculum is aligned with state standards, and the SBDM is ensuring procedures are in place for removing all barriers to learning.

Policy

Our yearly Comprehensive School Improvement Planning (CSIP) process will include:

- Frankfort High will ensure it implements a curriculum based on state and national standards.
- An analysis of state accountability data to discover areas of deficit and to what extent students and certain groups of students are meeting state standards.
- Systematic work to discover and correct causes of and barriers to high performance by all students will take place and the movement of students toward closing achievement gaps.
- The CSIP will be rooted in the needs assessment data for that year. If analysis
 uncovers a deficit in the alignment of curriculum and standard our plan will set
 goals and address any indicated alignment issues to help move our students to
 meet the standards set by the state.

We will implement this process to address our alignment with state standards and the resulting plan will be monitored by the council through on-going implementation and impact checks at least two times per year.
