## Frankfort High School Extracurricular Programs Participation and Eligibility

## **Policy Statement**

The Extracurricular Programs Participation and Eligibility Policy is intended to act as a guide in determining whether or not a student is academically and/or behaviorally eligible to participate in extracurricular activities not associated with a grade in a class.

## **Policy**

Frankfort abides by all KHSAA Policies. The Frankfort High School-Based Decision Making Council has passed the following athletic eligibility policy.

- 1. Each Monday, after ESS which is approximately 4 pm, grades will be run by the Athletic Director. The eligibility week runs from Monday to Monday.
- 2. Student-athletes may miss no more than one (1) period of the school day of competition without a valid doctor's note to be eligible to participate.
- 3. To be eligible to participate in competition a student shall not be failing more than 25% of the credit-bearing course load in which they are currently enrolled. For Summit courses students will be deemed failing if either of the following occurs:
  - a. Projects that have not been submitted by the due date and/or that have been submitted but do not obtain the appropriate Cognitive Skill Level. (Red Projects)
  - b. Power Focus Areas are not completed by the assigned due date. (Red Power Focus Areas)

For students taking non-Summit courses such as Extension Courses or Dual Credit College Courses students must maintain a grade of "C" or higher and it will be the course teacher's responsibility to update grades in Infinite Campus Weekly. Students who are academically ineligible will be permitted to attend practice but not participate. (KHSAA By-Law 9)

4. If a student is suspended out of school, the student will not be allowed to participate in any competition for the eligibility week. At the discretion of the principal, students that spend time in Panther Transition Academy (PTA) may/may not be allowed to participate in any competition for the eligibility week.
