

State of Michigan Seal of Biliteracy¹ Steps to Attainment

Grades 9-11

- 1. Student and parents/guardians contact the student's counselor to express interest in the Seal of Biliteracy.
- 2. Counselor tracks student progress toward graduation.
- 3. Students continues to practice and develop skill in the target language(s).

Grade 12

- 1. In the fall of senior year Student fills out HVS Seal of Biliteracy Application to be assessed the target language(s) in the first semester through spring of senior year.
 - a. Transfer students and/or students with heritage/mother language proficiency will apply and work with their counselor to compile acceptable documentation (i.e. official transcripts from a school in a foreign country showing at least one year of instruction in all subjects in a language other than English in Grade 6 or beyond).
 - b. Apply in Student Services for the December 2022 test date in November, and then take the STAMP 4S or STAMP WS on December 13, 2022 at 7:21 am, or student registers for and takes another assessment as approved by the Michigan Department of Education².
- 2. Students and counselors receive results from STAMP 4S/WS or other assessment approximately 1 week after completion of the test. To receive the Seal of Biliteracy, students must reach the intermediate-high score minimum² in *each* of the domains assessed.
 - a. Portions of the STAMP 4S/WS test where student results do not meet minimum score criteria may be retaken:
 - If only ONE domain scores below intermediate-high (and scores at intermediate-low), then students may retake that domain ONLY, between February 13-March 13, 2023 (student must re-apply).
 - ii. If more than one domain scores below intermediate-high, or is more than one level below intermediate-high, then students may retake the FULL exam, between March 14-24, 2023.
- 3. If score minimums are met, Student Services will confirm that the student is on-track for graduation, and the district will apply to the State Department of Education on behalf of the student for the Seal of Biliteracy no later than April of the student's senior year.
- 4. Students who earn the Seal will be recognized during graduation festivities with a certificate and seal to be placed on their diploma indicating this achievement.
