- b. APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL/AGREEMENT FOR SCHOOL FACILITY CONSULTING SERVICES WITH JACK SCHREDER & ASSOCIATES, INC.

The attached proposal provides assistance with the State School Facility Program (SFP) to assist Le Grand Union Elementary School District with securing State Allocation Board approvals for eligible facilities funding for the purpose of modernization. The SFP provides funding for

modernization on a 60/40 state and local sharing basis. Planning funding is only available for districts that qualify for financial hardship assistance. All or a portion of district contributions are paid by the state for districts that qualify for financial hardship assistance. It is recommended the Board of Trustees approve the Proposal/Agreement for School Facility Consulting Services with Jack Schreder & Associates, Inc.

c. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #18-19-4: PROVISIONAL INTERN PERMIT FOR 6TH GRADE TEACHER - CRYSTAL TAPETILLO A Provisional Intern Permit (PIP) is a permit issued at the request of an employing school district, County Office of Education, or state agency to fill a temporary staffing vacancy or need. They are issued for a minimum of six months, but not more than one year. Individuals must complete a baccalaureate degree, CBEST, and a minimum number of units or verify subject matter competence to qualify for the permit. Employers must provide orientation, guidance and assistance to holders of emergency permits.
