e-Learning Plan for Parents

E-Learning days will be implemented in the 2022-2023 school year. If we experience any inclement weather days or need to cancel an in-person school day, e-Learning will replace in-person learning. Below are the key highlights to be aware of when an e-Learning day goes into effect.



Communication:



- When an e-Learning day goes into effect, communication will be delivered via phone, radio, email, district website, and on social media sites.
- Students will not come to school, therefore, buses will not run.
- Families will receive information, via email, by 9:00 am the morning of an e-Learning day.
- Teachers, principals, and other licensed professionals will be available by email or phone from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Staff will do their best to respond in a timely manner during scheduled hours.

Grades 5-8 Academics:

Learning Platform and Schedule: We will be using a common platform and schedule to make e-Learning easier for families with multiple students. Assignments will consist of exposure to new material, review of previously taught material, or independent practice of material.

- Complete Packet 1 for the first snow day. Complete Packet 2 for the second snow day.
