It is moved that the Board of Education find there is cause to expel Student No. 22214 from all schools in the District for violation of Education Code

- 48915 (B) Possession of any knife or other dangerous object of no reasonable use to the pupil.

Student No. 22214 shall be expelled from the schools of the District for the remainder of the fall and spring semester 2018-2019 school year. It is further recommended that student 22214 may re-enroll at Orestimba High School at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year.

Mrs. Conforti – Thank you students, staff and parents


