They got to use fire hoses and water Hoy Park field! 4th Grade went to Lake Siskiyou and learned about trailmaking by Tom Hesseldenz, who designed Lake Siskiyou trail. He explained to the group what the landscape looked like before the lake was there and how he designed the trail. 5th graders went on a 1.8 mile hike to Horse Camp on Mount Shasta at 8,000 ft. They discussed several topics including; wilderness, weather, topography, John Muir, and Olberman's Causeway. 8th graders went to Yreka this week to participate in a health fair and examine career pathways in health.
