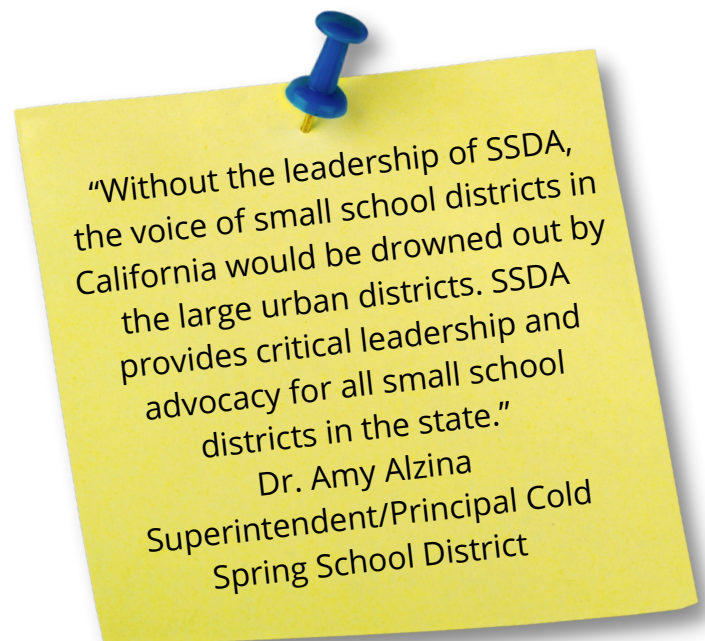
## LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY
