Rock County Christian School (RCCS) invites nominations and applications for the position of Head of School. A college-preparatory school, RCCS is very proud of the high school's 4-star rating with the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. RCCS opened in 1985 and educates students from grades K-12, partnering with parents and churches to equip students to thrive in all facets of their lives — spiritually, academically, emotionally, socially, and physically. RCCS has enjoyed significant enrollment growth (~70%) in the last several years. The school is debt-free and has recently enhanced its physical space (a newer gym, soccer field, science lab, and a number of cosmetic enhancements) while also securing grant funding to start an entrepreneurship program. Students are encouraged to discover and cultivate their God-given talents, challenging themselves and each other to realize their full potential while developing a deep sense of service to others they will carry forward into the rest of their lives. Various student activities are available, including athletic, academic, musical, artistic, service, and speech.

The lower and upper school campuses are located a convenient 15-minute drive apart in Beloit (grades 6-12) and Janesville (grades K-5), Wisconsin. A growing and diverse student body represents eight communities and 40 different church congregations in northern Illinois and southern Wisconsin. The historically-industrial area has seen a renaissance over the last dozen years with new business growth, readily-available social, cultural and outdoor activities, and a diverse community that continues to reinvent itself. We enjoy small-town charm with access to the larger communities of Madison, Milwaukee, and Chicago, all within a convenient two-hour drive.

The Head of School reports to the Rock County Christian School Board and is responsible for administering the operations of the school.

The new Head of School will lead a talented group of over 40 faculty and staff members committed to teaching, serving and supporting the school's 250+ students. The most qualified candidate will be unapologetically Christian, a relationship-builder who has excellent communication skills, and strong academic and leadership abilities. Must possess a Master's Degree in a related field, demonstrated history of effectiveness in leadership of a Christian school, at least 3-5 years experience in Christian educational administration, ministry, or Christian leadership. Of particular importance will be the need for the new Head to share a strategic vision for a school that has seen steady enrollment growth.
