• Southwest High School is located Washburn, MO. Students who reside in Seligman, MO. attend Southwest High as well. As of 2020, the population in Washburn was 531.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Southwest is an accredited school district with 700 students enrolled in 2021, district wide. High School enrollment for 2021 was 234.
- Partner with Scott Regional Technology Center (SRTC) in Monett, MO. Student can attend SRTC for career training in a number of programs, including Health Occupations, Marketing, Early Childhood Education, Culinary, JROTC, Welding. Autobody, Auto Mechanics, Diesel Technology, Machining and Construction.
