War Eagle Mill	War Eagle Mill's 18-foot undershot water wheel rotates when water from the War Eagle Creek strikes the paddles or blades at the bottom of the wheel. The force of the water's movement drives the blades of the wheel, which rotates a turbine that drives the mill's machinery.
