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## **Principal's Message**

Dear Cossitt Families,

Knowing just how welcoming a three day weekend can be, the actual rationale for such a weekend can very easily fade deeply into the background of sleeping in and hanging out. Every year I tend to feel like this becomes the fate of Martin Luther King Jr. 's birthday (his actual birthday was yesterday).

The great irony behind all of this has to do with the many enduring stories of great heroism and sacrifice that encompassed so much of his short life upon this earth. HIs story and the story of the Civil Rights movement should be available and shared in ways big and small, always and always.

I have linked below the story of how it was that he actually ended up in Memphis in April of 1968. While we should never minimize the power and message behind the I Have A Dream speech five years earlier, there was so much more behind the goals and aspirations of Dr. King and the movement that he led.

He was in Memphis in April of 1968 to help lend his support to a sanitation workers strike that was taking place. As is often the case with history, the easy, the simple and the visual becomes the default setting. His presence and his approach towards this strike is much harder to capture in a short story in comparison to the much more theatrical availability of the March on Washington.

In many ways however, I tend to feel like we miss much of what really ends up being responsible for great and lasting change to ultimately take place.

The rebuilding and reconstruction of the new and the better . . . one small brick at a time.

## **PUSHCOIN UPDATE**

Pushcoin has updated their system to allow users to make payments of any value amount. In the past there has been a minimum of \$35 payment; users can now enter any amount to make payments through Pushcoin.

From the payment screen, manually enter any dollar amount, do not use the drop-down option. The drop-down will show various pre-set amounts like \$35, but can be overridden to any amount desired.

## **KINDERGARTEN FAMILIES**

It is that time of year when we conduct another round of FastBridge, our universal reading and math screener, with our kindergarten students. FastBridge will give us an updated snapshot of your child's early literacy and math skills compared to their peers across the nation. Information gathered this round will include skills such as word segmenting and decoding words, as well as number sequencing and decomposing (breaking apart numbers into smaller parts), among other skills. This screener continues to be only one piece of your child's assessment portfolio. You will receive scores in February and be contacted if your child's comprehensive profile indicates the need for any additional support.

If your child is planning on attending,


a parent or guardian will need to be present.




