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Principal's Message

Dear Cossitt Families,

What could honestly be more fitting on a snowy weekend than to cuddle up to a fire with some warm cocoa and have a listen to a 55 minute podcast talking about math.

Fear not intrepid warriors.

As a lifelong school math struggler, I am here to affirm the magic and beauty of this wonderful podcast. (I purposely chose the "school" to put into the last line ahead of "math struggler").

Like so many things in our profession, the essence and curiosity of learning (with completely pure intentions) is all too often bled dry with traditional class work, with the end result being that we inadvertently blow out the candle.

What I found most fascinating about this podcast is the exceptionally relevant reminder that math is a means to an end. Or I should say more in keeping with the podcast, mathematical thinking is a means to an end.

As both a parent and educator, I have very much found myself at times getting bogged down, deep into the weeds, with math curriculum questions, cut scores, and assessment trends. Without attempting to minimize the importance of any of these, I do feel like we would be wiser and more effective in our profession if we were to do a better job of keeping our eyes on the ball.

Knowing that in actuality, ALL learning and subjects in schools should be viewed as springboards towards the grander and more important focus on living a good life and being a wise and thoughtful person.

Sometimes it just feels like Math should treated more like mathematical thinking and rather than shrinking the focus onto a slide to put into a microscope that limits our view, we should be more adventurous and ambitious with wanting to reawaken our children to the fascination of looking for and seeking out patterns that will inevitably help them make more sense of the world around them.

In other words, let's think about trading in our microscopes for telescopes.

All in all, not a bad way to spend our exploration time together each day in math.



FastBridge will give us an updated snapshot of your child's early literacy and math skills compared to their peers across the nation. Information gathered this round will include skills such as word segmenting and decoding words, as well as number sequencing and decomposing (breaking apart numbers into smaller parts), among other skills. This screener continues to be only one piece of your child's assessment portfolio. You will receive scores in February and be contacted if your child's comprehensive profile indicates the need for any additional support.

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


