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Principal's Message

** BELOW ARE INFORMATIONAL LETTERS REGARDING THE UPCOMING ADMINISTRATION OF THE 5ESSENTIALS SURVEY. THE FIRST LETTER HAS INFORMATION AND A LINK FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS. THE SECOND LETTER REFERS TO THE STUDENT COMPONENT (4TH THROUGH 6TH GRADERS)

Dear Cossitt Parent/Guardian,

Beginning January 24, students and teachers across Illinois were given an opportunity to begin to participate in the eleventh annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of Cossitt School. **As a parent/guardian**, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about Cossitt.

On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains.

These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction

Prior research in more than 400 schools has shown that schools that were strong on at least three of these “5 Essential” indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading than those that were weak on three or more Essentials

All teachers and 4th through 12th grade students will be responding to this survey.

5Essentials Reports will be generated for schools if their teachers and/or **students meet the response rate threshold of 50 percent**. These reports will be sent to schools and districts in May, 2023 and will also be included in the State School Report Card

Additionally, D102 has chosen to provide the optional **Parent survey supplement**. If **at least 20 percent of Cossitt parents complete this survey, a parent supplement report will also be generated**. The parent data will not be reported on the State Report Card.

Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at Cossitt school and help to guide improvement. **Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child.**

The Illinois 5Essentials Survey for students and teachers will be conducted January 24, 2023 through March 31, 2023. The Parent Survey Supplement will be conducted during that same timeframe.

*tea is a specialty item

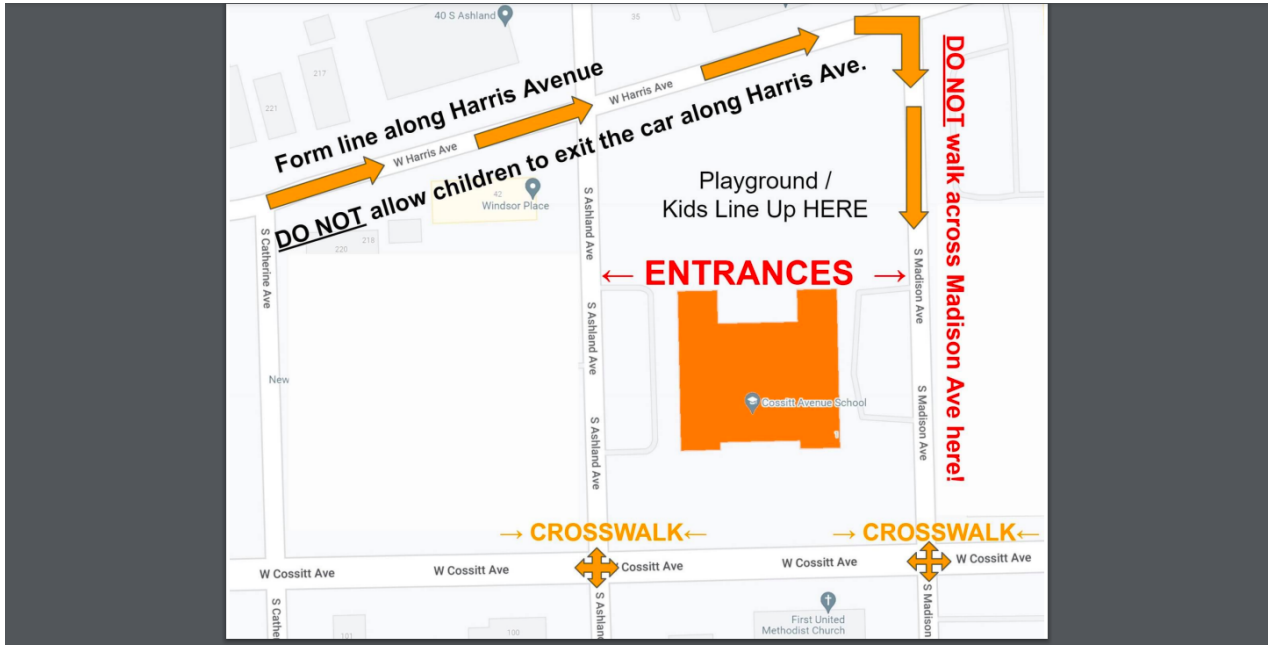
*other nonperishable items such as

It is that time of year when we conduct another round of FastBridge, our universal reading and math screener, with our kindergarten students. FastBridge will give us an updated snapshot of your child's early literacy and math skills compared to their peers across the nation. Information gathered this round will include skills such as word segmenting and decoding words, as well as number sequencing and decomposing (breaking apart numbers into smaller parts), among other skills. This screener continues to be only one piece of your child's assessment portfolio. You will receive scores in February and be contacted if your child's comprehensive profile indicates the need for any additional support.

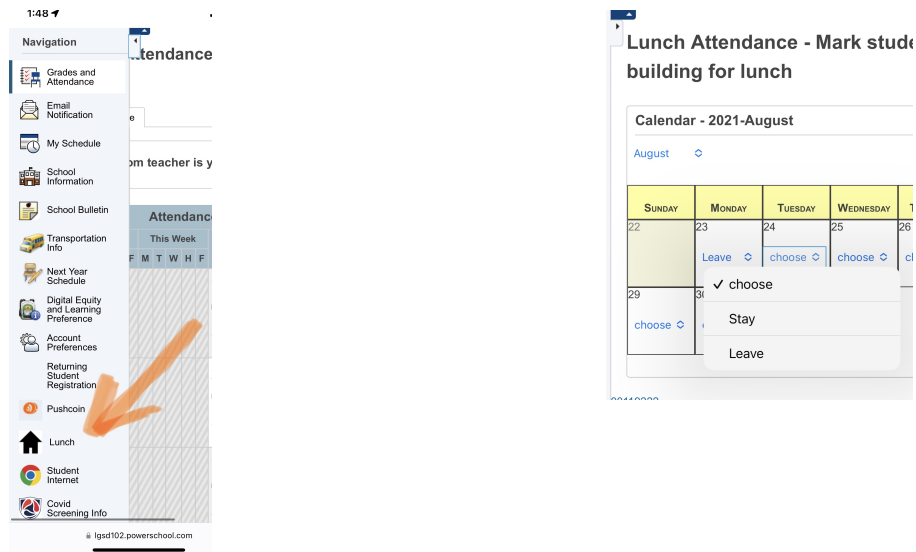

Going Home for Lunch??

If you want your child to leave campus for lunch. You need to make sure that you check them out in the Parent Portal on PowerSchool as well as remind your child as well, so they can let their teacher know. If your child is not checked out in PowerSchool, we will not let your child leave the building. Lunch pick up is at 11:20 and line up is at 12:05 on the blacktop. Your child may not enter through the main office, they need to enter from the blacktop.
