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Principal's Message

Good afternoon,

Just because I feel like I continue to run into articles, podcasts, and broadcasts related to the recent CDC study cited in this piece, I wanted to share out one of the more thorough and thoughtful of the articles (*The Crisis In American Girlhood*). Above and beyond my role as an educator, I am the father of two daughters who was also raised in a house with three sisters.

While the current media iteration of oversized headlines and screeching references to the sky-is-falling can sometimes create narratives of complete chaos in the world, we would be wise to carefully consider when warning lights such as these are actually trying to get our attention.

One subheading in the article that has truly stuck with me is the reference to the fact that Teens Are Really Good At Hiding It. The challenging world of mental health struggles is all too often surrounded by a thick, almost impenetrable layer of hidden pain. This is then exacerbated by the reliance on public consumption smiles and affirmations to their loved ones that, "everything is fine . . . why do you keep asking me?"

What I most valued about this article is the one thing I value most about any such stories about mental health: the avoidance of the singular cause and equally alluring singular solution. The overlapping threads and layers that exist within our mental health makeup is simply too complex and elusive to rely on the seeking out of the one and only culprit

That does not however preclude us from paying extra close attention to the culture at large and to endlessly seek to create explicit space and time to engage with our children. Without necessarily wanting to add to the narrative that our world is unraveling, I do strongly encourage you to take some time over the long weekend and read the article. Like with so much in our lives, becoming more knowledgeable and aware of mental health challenges taking shape around us will at the very least increase and improve our hearing and vision.

That is an invaluable first step in joining the conversation.

Going Home for Lunch??

If you want your child to leave campus for lunch. You need to make sure that you check them out in the Parent Portal on PowerSchool as well as remind your child as well, so they can let their teacher know. Your child may not enter through the main office, they need to enter from the blacktop.
