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Principal's Message

Good afternoon,

Good afternoon,

As we approach the joyful transition from February to March (sorry February, but you really are the shortest longest month), I just wanted to check in with some updates on ongoing and upcoming points of interest.

- As we have now shared in both bulletin and text, we are continuing to beat the drum for additional parent survey feedback for the 5Essentials Survey. The necessary threshold for there to be a formal report shared with schools is 20%. As of this writing, we are at 15%. I am encouraging our Cossitt community to help us out and set aside a few minutes this weekend to help us get over the 20% barrier. http://survey.5-essentials.org/illinois/survey/parent/
- · Regarding our ongoing carline revamping, we are in the process of finalizing the use of traffic cones all the way down the center of Madison each morning. Once they are available and ready to be utilized, a formal communication will be forthcoming. For those of you who have shared your concerns (as I myself have witnessed as well), the reality is that school based emails stressing the importance of slowing down and following the carline have very limited value. The traffic cones will help us eliminate the dangerous practice of U-turns on Madison during carline drop offs as well as the perceived need to come all the way up the center of Madison to then swerve into the front of the carline. An additional concern that is still ongoing is that of those who park across the street and then walk their children directly across Madison rather than use the Harris/Madison crosswalk, While there is no question that these practices reflect the morning hurray up rushrushrush, like many of you, I am anxious to avoid any potential accidents that might take place in the future, but could have been long ago predicted.
- Even though we will revisit this in next week's Bulletin, just a reminder that we are coming up on the 22-23 IAR State Tests for grades 3 through 6 here at Cossitt. Our first day of testing will be on Tuesday, March 7th. These tests are administered each year in the Spring. They

- assess Math and English Language Arts (5th grade is additionally assessed in Science). You should expect to get more detailed information from your grade level teachers ahead of the actual testing week.
- One more small point of interest regarding students going home for lunch. In the past, the expectation had been that students who go home for lunch should plan on returning to school shortly before the bell would ring for the afternoon session to begin. Over the last couple of years, we are finding more and more students returning to the area closer to the noon hour. While we have made a point of allowing them to join the second half of recess when this occurs, my own concern ends up being that that is a block of time when they are not officially accounted for. Some students come straight to the office, others come straight to the recess gates and look for someone to let them in, and others will come towards the recess gate and stay on the sidewalk side and chat with friends. None of these by themselves are overly concerning. Just because of the looseness of this process, I am asking that whenever possible, to please encourage your home lunch students to return closer to the time when the lunch block is officially over (the bell rings at 12:12).

Ahead of what looks to be Monsoon Monday, very much hoping that everyone enjoys their sunny springlike Sunday!




