C. Reports

2. Administrative Report: Ken Graff, Principal

- 03/01 Kinder Roundup at 5:30pm-7:00pm starting in MPR, then in classrooms. Parapros, Kinder specialists, PTA will be available, library and Community Programs will be open. Goal is 100 kinders for next year, hoping for at least 80 tomorrow night.
- $4^{\text {th }}$ Grade Music performance coming up.
- Report cards going home Friday, end of $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ Quarter.
- Intersession first week of break M 03/06 through Th 03/09, all day. Reading 8-11, 30 min lunch, 11:30-2:30 math. $1^{\text {st }}$ through $5^{\text {th }}$ grade offered. Primary and Intermediate Special Education intersession, AM only. $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade group will be split into two sections.
- 4Q $1^{\text {st }}$ week back: Friday Honor Roll and Awards Ceremony. $3^{\text {rd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ grade combined, then $5^{\text {th }}$ separate. $4^{\text {th }}-5^{\text {th }}$ will get honor roll certs and ribbons/plaques/trophies for performance on last year's state tests. Testing will start the following week.

## III. Old Business

## A. 2022-2023 Staffing and Enrollment

- Currently have 703 students enrolled (0 in Vail Virtual Learning). Projected 705.
- Difference between $5^{\text {th }}$ and Kinder is $27=$ declining enrollment.
- Currently fully staffed. Ms. Payne on leave for family matter, coming back after Spring Break. Ms. O’Dell subbing.
- Ms. Rangel has a student teacher Jenna Baye. See if she may work out for a future opening.
- Ms. Brozeman will be on regular contract instead of LT sub.
- Ms. Kershner to be full time next year.
- Fully staffed in SpEd department. Ms. Wettstein is only for this year, not coming back next year.


## B. Facilities Update

- Ms. Jepson reported that there is now lighting on the walkway by the greenhouse and library. Also have updated toilets in the front office. A work order has been placed to repaint crossing areas in the parking lot.
- Ms. McGowan reported that signs around the parking lot and circle are weathered. Mr. Graff had just talked with Tori to have new signs installed.
- Ms. Shioya mentioned there are branches that hang into the right pickup lane that are unavoidable on cars.
- Mr. Graff reported that 8 ft wrought iron fencing (with crash bars) around the outer perimeter of the school (including between 400 and 500 bldgs) will be installed in the next month. CFMS will be starting next week, then move on to Sycamore. The interior playground fencing will stay 5 ft for now. Preschool buildings ( 700 building) will also be updated to 8 ft . The wall by the library will have fencing added to the top to match the 8 ft height. Will no longer be blue, now a sand color to blend in.
- Front shade structure still planned for end of April. Two by $1^{\text {st }}$ grade, two by $5^{\text {th }}$ grade.
- Down the road with next year's budget, work on repairing more water fountains.


## IV. New Business

## A. 2023-2024 Staffing and Enrollment

Mr. Graff reports that current January projection is 682 students. Sycamore will be moving to an all-day Kindergarten model, which changes the FTE enrollment divisor to 20.5 students (used to be 21.9), district-wide. Currently working on staff placements and hiring.

Planning 5 Kinder, 4 first grade (would be a little above cap), 5 second grade, 5 third grade, 4 fourth grade, 4 fifth grade, 2 resource teachers (not inclusion), achievement teachers (Ms. Pangle) district takes all but 0.8, Adv math (district budgets for half), PE, Music, SUMS, Art. ELP picks up half - next year, moving to cluster model (more next mtg), district incentivizes by paying for full-time ELP. We're 0.2 over with this model.

Grant funded positions have ended so need to absorb that. 27 classroom teachers currently. Next, go over the support budget for the support positions.

Most teachers have signed contracts, others on delay list (due end of March). Kinder: 2 new teachers needed, 1 in mind. $1^{\text {st. }}$. All staying but one may need to move. $2^{\text {nd. }}$ : Ms. Payne retiring end of this year, so need new teacher. $3^{\text {rd }}$ : If move to 4 classes, can move someone around, but all are returning. $4^{\text {th }}$ : All returning. $5^{\text {th }}$ : Ms. Rangel leaving Sycamore, so Ms. Wright will move to $5^{\text {th }}$ grade. Also may have another leaving Sycamore. Need new PE teacher, other Specials still here. Resource staying. Ms. Porter will be Behavioral and student services. Waiting to see if grant for social worker/counselor gets approved. Ms. Hahn unsure. May need 2 SpEd positions but for now, they're staying. Staffed but waiting to see what shakes out with Kinder enrollment, people coming back, etc.

This will remain on the agenda as a running item through the end of the year.

## B. AASA: Arizona Academic Standards Assessments

Mr. Graff: Testing to begin the week of March $27^{\text {th }}$ and continue through April. Students will be assessed in math, writing, and ELA standards. $5^{\text {th }}$ graders will also take a science assessment.
