GRANTS AWARDED TO JOSHUA CIRCLE AND JUNIPER ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

The Board accepted and approved two grants for Joshua Circle Elementary and Juniper Elementary Schools for the 2015/16 school year. The Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Grant awarded to Joshua Circle Elementary in the amount of \$4,105.00 and the Action for Healthy Kids School Grant awarded to Juniper Elementary in the amount of \$2,500.00 would provide additional fresh fruit and vegetables to students during the day time.

323 Teacher Responses

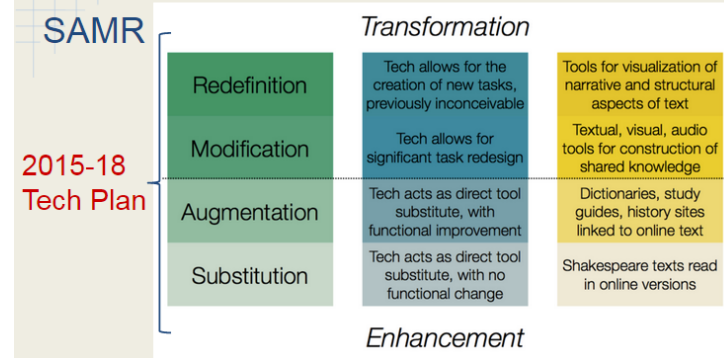
Daily Chromebook Use

64% of students grades 2-12 report using their Chromebook at least half of each day

- Grades 2-3: 73%
- Grades 4-6: 69%
- Grades 7-12: 59%

59% of teachers embed Chromebook use in their instructional plans on a daily basis

- Sufficient infrastructure upgrades

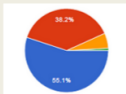
