OHHS ANATOMY CLASS NUTRITION PRESENTATION

Students from Mr. Comberiat's first period class at OHHS shared a presentation titled "The Nutrition Act." Their focus was nutrition, healthy food choices, school lunches and suggestions for change. They presented research on processed foods and student survey results. They also met with the District Nutritionist to discuss their ideas and to have a better understanding of the current lunch program. They expressed their surprise to learn about the cost of feeding students.
