SPECIAL EDUCATION-YEAR IN REVIEW

Matt Fedders, Director of Special Services presented a Special Education Year End Review for the 2015/16 school year. The presentation provided a snapshot of the various services provided to the 2,478 students receiving services on a daily basis by both certificated and classified employees. Mr. Fedders shared that the Special Education Department provided a full continuum of services and related services necessary to access education for students that included: speech, occupational therapy, adaptive PE, assistive technology, special circumstance aides and DHH interpreters. Additionally, general education services that were provided throughout the year included: nursing/health, social/emotional support and section 504 plans. A breakdown

of Special Education funding and expenses was provided along with a three-year plan including goals, upcoming challenges, staffing, and a list of LCAP priorities. Successes from all age groups of students served were highlighted and a video of student achievements was presented. Mr. Fedders thanked his hard working staff for their dedicated and compassionate work. He emphasized that, "We have no special needs children, just children with special needs."
