6. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This year summer school will run from June 5 through June 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for students. A morning snack and bagged lunch will be provided to the students. It will be held at the Intermediate School for both Primary and Intermediate students. The Junior/Senior High School will have junior high summer school and credit recovery for high school students.

The sewer taps have been approved for installation at the bus barn. The heating is currently being worked on and the drywall has been completed. Superintendent Lovato said he is still looking at a June 1 completion date, but stated it does depend on contractor's timeliness.

Whitlock Construction will begin tearing up the floor next week at the Primary School to repair the plumbing issues there. Superintendent Lovato said hopefully the project won't be as intrusive as predicted, but he said the district is prepared if it is. Valley Plumbing jet washed the pipes at the Junior/Senior High School and the drainage is working much better. Superintendent Lovato said it has helped that students haven't been flushing massive amounts down the drain. Central Office has been experiencing plumbing and natural gas issues as well. The boiler system is very old and Superintendent Lovato said it will need to be replaced.

A special session has been scheduled for June 6. This meeting will include a financial report. Superintendent Lovato said the district's auditor and Mark Rydberg from the Colorado Department of Education have been in contact and the last few adjustments have been made to the audit. Superintendent Lovato said it should be ready to submit by Friday. He said the next task will be to input the numbers into the budget.

Superintendent Lovato said he would like to get going on the calendar for next year and not wait until January to discuss processes. The policies that pertain to the calendar have been shared with the Board.

Director Bickel inquired about payroll. She wondered if the issue has been resolved and if the employee received an answer. Superintendent Lovato said a meeting with ADP was scheduled and ADP needs to make adjustments. He said he hasn't received any communication for ADP yet. Director Bickel said one of the biggest complaints was not receiving a return phone call from the office. He explained he was out of state at that time. Superintendent Lovato shared with the Board that he has submitted ledger codes for full-time staff to ADP in order for them to create a report that will work with our software program, SDS. He still has to submit codes part-time staff.

Director Derbigny noticed the number of summer school teachers and asked how many students will be attending summer school. Ms. Fraker said between 60 and 80 Primary students and Mrs. Romero said around 68 Intermediate students will be asked to attend summer school. It was shared that some of the students encouraged to attend are students who are on the edge and teachers don't want them to lose much over the summer. There will be some students who will be unable to attend due to various reasons.
