August 16: First day of school (11:30 dismissal)


Regular School Hours: 8:15 a.m.-3:05 p.m.


Students may arrive at 8:00 or after. A grab and go breakfast is available at 8:00.

Student Drop Off & Pick Up

Students can be dropped off prior to 8:15 am on Madison Street as well as the main parking lot. The picture below shows the car lane used for student drop off. The drop off lane in the main parking lot will only be available in the morning. After school pick up will require parents to park in a designated parking space.

Parents can still park in the main parking lot and walk their kids up to the building. We ask that they not walk them throughout the building. As for pick up, parents can still wait in the grassy area out front for dismissal or wait in their cars on the north side of the building on Madison St.





Bus Information from Director Oplt

All community route maps with stops can be found by clicking this link. Please note some buses are rural routes that do not have community stops.

We have reduced our working fleet of buses by 3, causing some changes in bus routes. Some bus numbers have changed and that information can be found in Skyward. <u>Most bus routes will have a pick up time at least 5 minutes earlier than previous years.</u>

It is important that all bus riders be at their pick up location five minutes prior to the time listed in Skyward. This is important for the community stop bus riders to maintain a very tight timeline.

Community stop maps for Bus 1, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 26 will be located on the PARENTS tab under the BUS subheading. Please take the time to locate the corresponding bus map and take note of the closest stop to your home.

We will be continuing to make changes in Skyward to the pickup times through the registration process. The pick up times in Skyward are accurate but may change slightly due to new student enrollment.

With the back to school evening being the 15th of August we encourage you to stop by and to meet your bus drivers and ask any questions you might have. This is important for first time riders and new parents to the district.

This will be the last year as Director of Transportation for Mr. Oplt. He will be succeeded by Elizabeth Stephens next school year.
