An additional \$12 per month is paid to an employee holding a high school diploma or its equivalent.

An additional \$11 per month is paid to an employee for holding each of the following numbers of college hours or comparable credit obtained in a trade or vocational school as approved by the State Board of Education: 12, 24, 36, 48, 60, 72, 84, 96, 108, 120 college hours; 180, 360, 540, 720, 900, 1080, 1260, 1440, 1620, 1800 comparable credit in a trade or vocational school.

An additional \$40 per month is paid to an employee for holding each of the following degrees: associates, bachelor's, master's, doctorate.

An additional \$11 per month is paid to an employee for holding each of the following: bachelor's degree plus 15 college hours, master's degree plus 15 college hours, master's degree plus 30 college hours, master's degree plus 45 college hours, master's degree plus 60 college hours.

An additional \$10 per month is paid to an employee for working a daily shift that includes work performed between 6 p.m. and 5 a.m. the following day.

Some employees may be entitled to other additional monthly pay based upon the requirements of the school laws of West Virginia.

Under a December 15, 2008 county board resolution, an additional lump sum of \$500 is annually, near January 30, paid to each employee (and prorated for employees whose annual contract term exceeds 200 days), but this additional payment must be discontinued if, in any school year, the local share funding for the additional pay is no longer available for any reason. With the passage of the FY '20,21,22,23 & 24 excess levy the rate increased to \$750. The rate further increased by \$50 in FY '22 to a total of \$800 to provide for an increase in vision examinations.
