Our school will be engaging in Social Emotional Learning (SEL) this year. This time will be called Cougar Connection. We will be focusing on the core competencies based on research done by the Collaborative Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning (CASEL). The five core competencies of social-emotional learning are: self-awareness, self-management, responsible decision making, relationship skills, and social awareness.

SEL is being implemented in an effort to cultivate a caring learning environment that actively involves all of our students as well as our staff. Research has consistently shown that developing the social and emotional skills of students helps them succeed academically, gain confidence, and have a more positive mindset.

Cougar Connection will be twenty minutes everyday during homeroom. Here are a few examples of SEL in the classroom: doing a read aloud with SEL themes, hosting a daily morning meeting with a greeting, teaching students how to listen actively and pay attention, creating calm down corners, practicing how to disagree respectfully, talking about managing emotions, giving students responsibilities, encouraging positive self-talk, setting goals, giving team tasks and encouraging teamwork, practicing mindfulness, and doing a daily check-in with students on their mood. These are teachable skills that can have lasting impacts on students.

We are excited about this new addition and the opportunity it is going to provide for our students.
