1.) CONTRACT APPROVED

The Board and Union officially reached an agreement by approving a 3-year agreement. Changes included statutory language, clarification items, and salary increases.

2.) BUDGET MATTERS

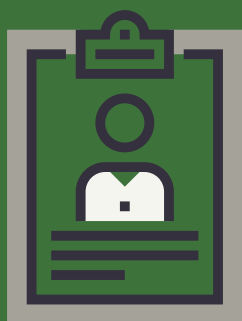


3.) SERVICE RENEWALS

5.) CERTIFIED SCHOOL NURSE

Nurse Greive has completed her certified school nurse training and has officially receive her license through ISBE. The Board approved her appointment to this role starting next school year.

6.) COACHING CHANGES

The Board approved boys basketball coaching changes for the next season. Coaches J. Brueggemann, S. Pfeiffer, and C. Smith resigned. Brendan Hand was approved as Head Coach and Matthew Burke will be serving as Assistant Coach. We welcome them to our District.
