



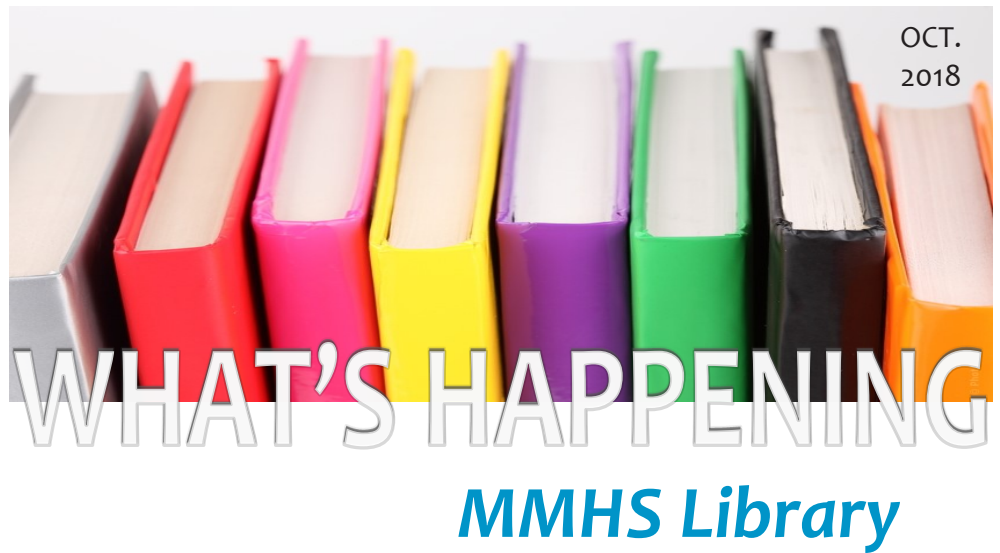

### The Book Fair

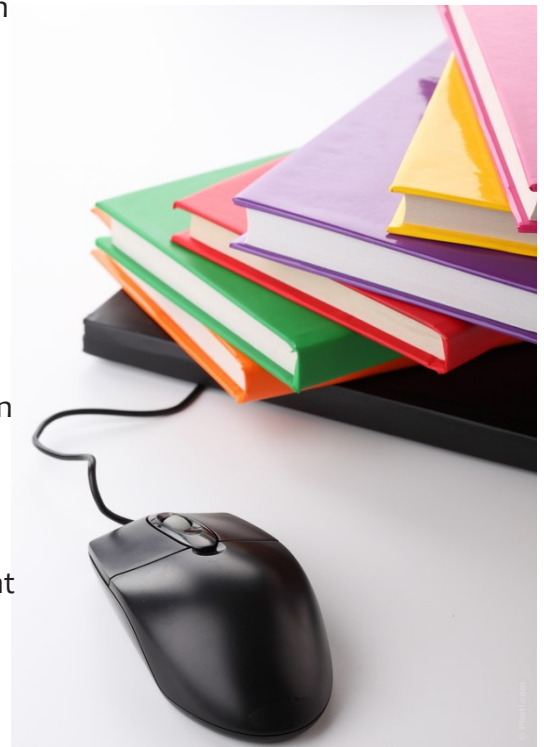
*When:* November 12-20, 2018

Research projects are an important part of education today. Unfortunately, students sometimes struggle finding a topic. GALE's Topic Finder is a great solution to this issue.

The Topic Finder is available

in almost all of the GALE databases, at the bottom of the home page. All students need to do is type in a broader topic (e.g.: World War II), and the Topic Finder will provide them with sub-topics (and associated articles) relating to it.

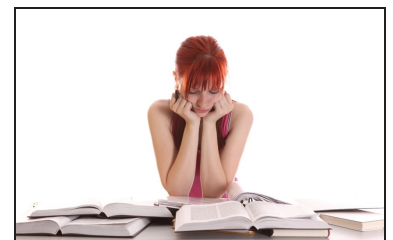
