#### **Message from the Principal:**

This is our yearly report of the 2017-2018 school year here at Wyandotte Middle School. This report shows our results compared to the state average.

Our results were what we expected as we continue making growth. We have made changes this school year to help our students become successful.

In terms of the math and reading area, we still focused hard on the areas of weakness. We used a program called IXL to help with the remediation of our students in individual area of needs. With the addition of chrome-books with our 8<sup>th</sup> graders we noticed some positive movement in the areas where they struggle the most. We continue to offer tutoring before school and at lunch. We initiated that every middle school student who had a grade below a 70% in a core subject area had mandatory tutoring with that teacher this year. That has shown some progress.

We continue to require our middle school students to take a separate Reading and English class as this will allow them extra time to work on the reading comprehension skills. We offer an Honors English class for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders as we feel this will help push some of our students who have the desire of more education.

Many of our teachers have attended and are registered to attend professional development opportunities this summer and throughout the school year. They continually look for ways to help children succeed in the classroom that are struggling as well as our higher achieving students.

We have witnessed growth in the students throughout this school year and we know that we will continue to rise and see success in our students.

We are continually striving to make sure your children get the best education to help them succeed in life. Thank you for allowing us the privilege to educate your child. They deserve only the best and that is what we plan to give them.

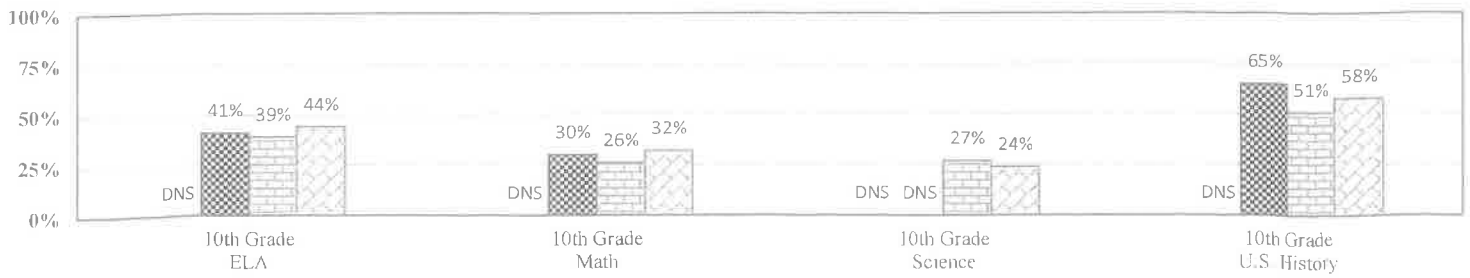

**% of Students Scoring Proficient and Above by Grade and Subject**

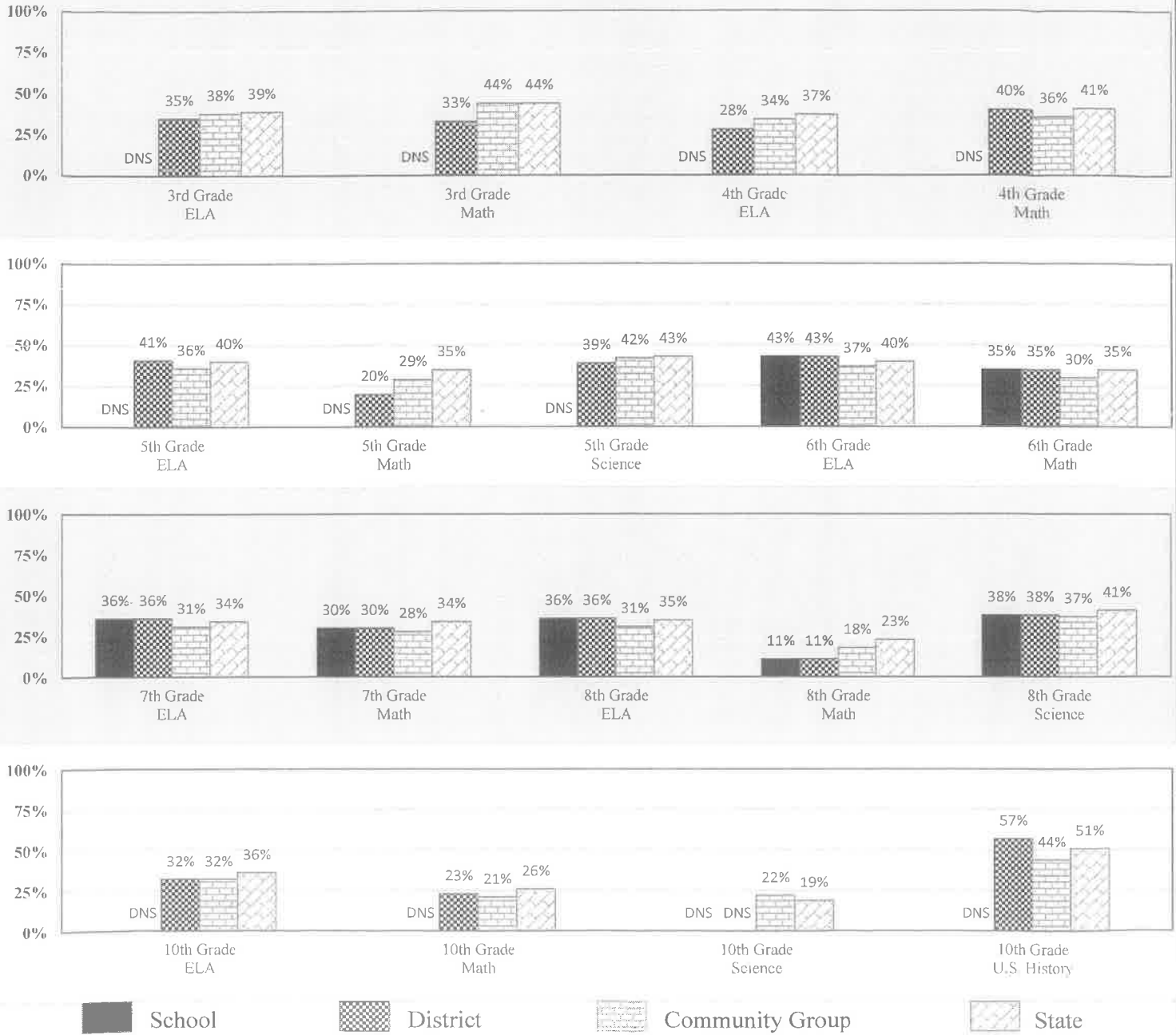
