

Did You Know...

Your Missouri tax liability can support scholarships for students to attend NCCS?

It's true!

The Missouri Legislature created the Missouri Empowerment Scholarship Accounts Program (MOScholars) in 2021 that can provide up to \$6,375 each year to support private education for low income and IEP students. Families can use these funds for educational expenses, including private school tuition.

These scholarships are funded through the MOScholars tax credit, a 100% tax credit for Missouri taxpayers who want to support the MOScholars program.

Traditionally, your Missouri income tax dollars go to Jefferson City for the legislature to decide what to spend it on. When you utilize the MOScholars tax credit you can redirect up to 50% of your state tax liability to support scholarships for students to use for private education, including tuition at NCCS, and you receive a full tax credit on this amount.

Peeked your interest? Here's what to do...

- Go to MOScholars.com and click the Tax Credit Reservation System tab.
- Complete & submit the Tax Credit Reservation Application
- Receive a confirmation of your tax credit reservation from the Missouri Treasurer's Office
- Within 30 days, send your check with the confirmation number to one of the two EAO's supporting NCCS students (Herzog Tomorrow Foundation or Children's Tuition Fund of Missouri)
- The EAO will send confirmation of your contribution to the Treasurer's Office which will then send a taxcredit certificate to the EAO for your records.
- When you file your Missouri taxes for that year, complete Missouri Form TC to include with your tax forms.
