How do we identify students?

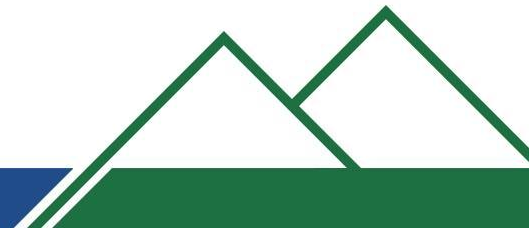
- Home Language Survey

- Annual language assessment, including: speaking, listening, reading and writing

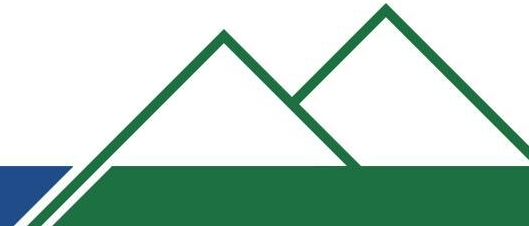
How do we know when they no longer need support (are exited)?

# What is our support model for MLL students?

## **Supportive Mainstream (Elementary)**

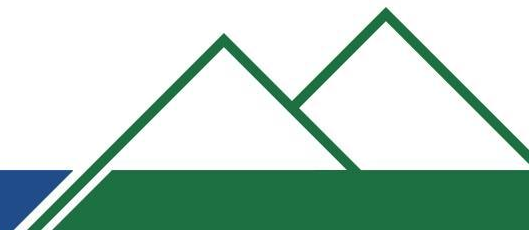
- MLL students access language acquisition instruction (reading, writing, speaking, listening) and support through small group, one-on-one support, co-teaching (can be inside/outside of classroom)
- MLL Students access grade-level content in general education classroom

## **Content-Based Sheltered Instruction (Secondary)**

- Pairs grade-level content with explicit language instruction
- Depending on language level, this could be a 'support/elective' class or count as an ELA credit

## **Professional Development**

- Guided Language Acquisition Design (GLAD)
- Co-Teaching Strategies



# How is our progress assessed?

## Assessment Criteria

1. Number and Percentage of Students who Exit\*
  - \*K-1 Average Score of 4.5, overall, and a minimum of 4 in each domain
  - \*2nd-12th Average Score of 5, overall, and a minimum score of 4 in each domain
2. Number and Percentage of Students who are able to meet proficiency standard on SBA (state test)
