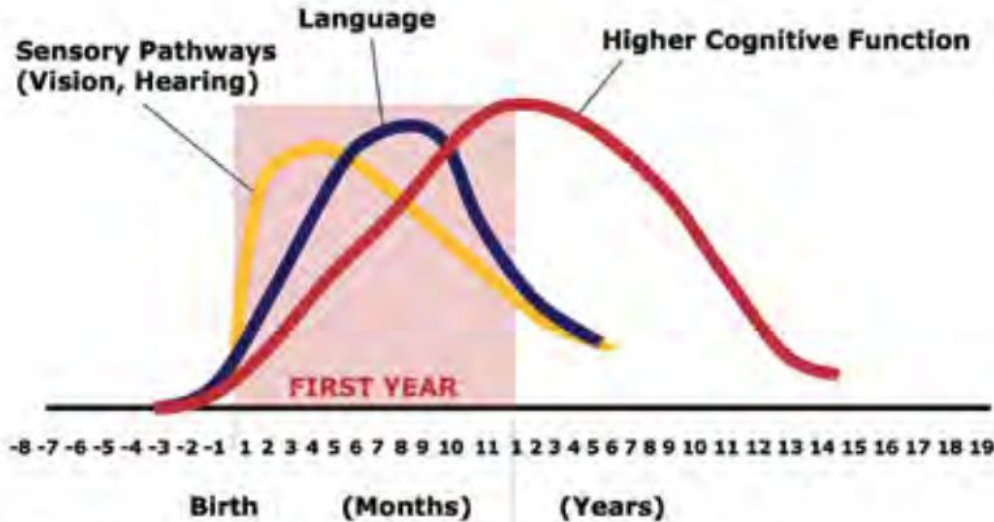

## Human Brain Development

Neural Connections for Different Functions Develop Sequentially



Early learning is about the whole child. Early learning covers all areas of a child's learning and development. In the years from birth through 3rd grade, children gain physical and social skills, and develop emotionally and cognitively. Nurturing the whole child from birth through 3rd grade is essential for preparing all children in Washington for the challenges of the 21st century.

# MP Campus - 3 Teachers and Classrooms

- One campus but three different classrooms
  - Same curriculum but different activities, projects, etc
  - Variety among classrooms for activities, rules and expectations
  - Much like an elementary school, teachers decide on their classroom activities individually
  - ECEAP Curriculum is the same in each full day classroom

# Late Arrival Procedure

- Late arrival procedure
  - Sign-in late arrivals at central location (Sign In)
  - Clipboard by the corner of the building for families to sign-in, please come all the way inside the gate and sign your child in
  - Anyone who arrives after the gate is closed must sign their child-in

# Program Requirements

  - Attendance: 10 days of consecutive absences we have to remove you from the program and fill your spot with a child from the waitlist
  - If your child is sick or you have a family circumstance, please contact family support
  - Conferences/Visits with teachers and family support

# Good Sleep and Rest

- Please prioritize sleep and rest at home
  - Full Day takes a lot of stamina, getting enough sleep at home is very important
  - It is a long, busy day for kids, if you need sleep resources, please contact Family Support
    - Quiet rest is not a naptime, it is a time to rest during the day

# Toileting and Clothing

- Please send a change of clothes, accidents do happen
- Clothing should be appropriate for play
  - Shoes they can run, jump and climb in
  - Clothes that they can play in and sit criss cross on the carpet
  - Comfortable and easy to move in

# Pick up and Drop off

- Thank you for picking up and dropping off your child on time
- We do not have before and after care
- Pick up and Drop off times are not flexible, we do not have childcare available
