What is Big Picture Learning?

Instead of traditional schooling where we bring curriculum to your students and measure their knowledge of it, our students will serve as our curriculum. Their interests and curiosities will drive their individual learning and will serve as the basis of demonstrating mastery of learning towards high school graduation requirements. We believe in experiential learning opportunities, which will result in students working with caring adults in the community that will partner with the school and your student(s) to create meaningful learning experiences.

When does school start? For Who? And What will it look like?

First Day of School: September 1, 2022

School Hours: 8:00 am - 2:45 pm

Who: All students grades 9-12, will start on the first day of school.

What will it look like:

Day 1 (September 1st): The opening day of school will celebrate Tulalip Heritage, and will be an opportunity to introduce Big Picture Learning for our students. We will build community and begin our journey towards re-imagining and individualizing education for all students.

Day 2 (September 2nd): We will be leaving campus to learn by walking to the Hibulb Cultural Center. This will require all students to have a <u>Field Trip Permission Form</u>; Please click on the link and try to send it with your student the first day of school, or email a copy to <u>carmen_phillips@msvl.k12.wa.us</u>, We also have paper copies available in the front office. This must be completed and submitted to the office no later than when we leave for Hibulb.

Our route will be to walk down 27th (The Quil) towards Marine and then continue to the Hibulb Cultural Center. The opportunity to stop at the food stands will be available as well as sack lunches.

My student/s ride the Bus, How does that work?

AM: Students who are riding the bus in the morning will ride to their prospective high school either Marysville Pilchuck or Marysville Getchell. From there a shuttle bus (at MP 21,28,80) (at MG 46, 63) will take all Heritage, Legacy, and 10th Street students to the Marysville/Tulalip Campus.

PM: Students riding the bus in the afternoon will ride a shuttle bus (CMS 51,52) (MMS 22,106) (TMS 36,37,78) to their prospective Middle School: Totem, Marysville Middle School, or Ceadercrest. From there, they will connect with their route to be taken home , or they will either ride a bus from the MS or walk home.

This may take a little bit for students to get used to, and we will be here to support our youth.
