Warm Weather Clothing

Believe it or not, the weather will change! As it warms up, summer clothing emerges from our closets. Please ensure that your child wears sensible clothes and shoes to school.

Below are some simple reminders:

A sweater, sweatshirt or lightweight coat may still be needed as the weather can change quickly from warm to chilly.

- ▶ The length of skirts and shorts should be lower than the child's fingertips when extended downward.
- ▶ Halter tops and skinny straps on shirts are not permitted.
- ▶ Shirts should be long enough to cover student's midriff at all times.

Title I Information
