The common items are identified on the list as such and should be easily obtained anytime during the summer.



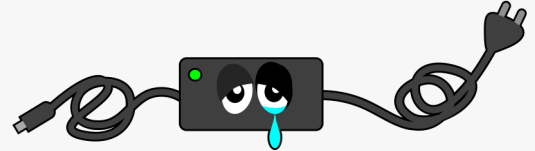
