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### Logistics and Information:

- **Session 1:** June 26 - July 7 on the following days: 6/26, 6/27, 6/28, 6/29, 6/30, 7/5, 7/6, 7/7. (on 7/3 and 7/4 there will be no-classes due to the 4th of July holiday)
- **Session 2:** July 11 - July 21 on the following days: 7/11, 7/12, 7/13, 7/14, 7/17, 7/18, 7/19, 7/20.
- During each session, there will be AM and PM classes:
  - **AM Class Times**
    - 9AM - 10:30AM; Asynchronous learning and teacher office hours.
    - 10:30AM - 12PM; Synchronous learning; students are expected to attend class on Zoom/Google Meet.
  - **PM Class Times**
    - 12:30PM - 2PM; Synchronous learning; students are expected to attend class on Zoom/Google Meet.
    - 2PM - 3:30PM; Asynchronous learning and teacher office hours.
- Synchronous learning is when students will be expected to be in a Zoom/Google Meet session with their teacher. Asynchronous is independent learning. Teachers will hold office hours during asynchronous learning times and be available on Zoom/Google Meet for assistance.

### Retrieval Credits Available:

- Students may receive a semester 0.5 credit for each class they attend and complete. Students may attend both Session 1 & Session 2 classes for a maximum of 4 classes and 2.0 credits.
- Final course offerings are dependent upon the number of students registered and instructor availability. Course options are listed on the registration form.
- Students must have regularly attended and failed or received an incomplete or NC in their regular high school class in order to be eligible to take a credit retrieval class. The amount of general knowledge a student gained and the efforts they put into a course during the regular school year is a direct indicator of whether or not they will be successful in a summer school credit retrieval course.

### Attendance & Grading:

- Students will be dropped after 2 absences. Failure to engage in assigned classwork, assessments, mandatory video class sessions, or one-to-one appointments set by the teacher will result in removal from the class.

- Summer school course completion is based on students demonstrating their knowledge of set standards within each course they enroll. Once a student has demonstrated this knowledge they will receive a “Pass” grade and credit for the course.

**Cost:**

- Summer Credit Retrieval is funded through state and federal grant funds.
- ALL 11th and 12th grade MSD students have free tuition to retrieve credits required for graduation due to the grant funds.
- 9th and 10th grade students will receive free tuition for any failed ELA/English or Math course that is required for graduation. All other courses, such as Science, Geography, PE, and others require \$125 tuition per course.
- Tuition must be received before the first day of each session.
