WE HAVE ALREADY HAD A COUPLE OF INCIDENTS WHERE TEASING AND HORSEPLAY HAVE LED TO AN UNFORTUNATE PHYSICAL INTERACTION, THIS IS NOT ACCEPTABLE IN THE CULTURE AND COMMUNITY OF 10TH STREET. WE HAVE HIGH EXPECTATIONS FOR THE BEHAVIOR OF OUR STUDENTS, AND WE ASK OUR PARENTS TO SUPPORT THOSE EXPECTATIONS.



10th Street Code of Conduct

As a responsible student at 10th Street School, I agree with the importance of a safe learning environment. Each of us has to work together to make positive, appropriate behavior choices.

- Speak up for others.
- Talk things out with people I trust.
- My opinion is important. I just have to remember how, when and where to make my voice heard.
- 4. I will sit by people who help me be a successful student.
- I will not spread rumors or make hurtful comments to or about others, either in person or online through chats and social media. These are the behaviors of a bully (a form of harassment).
- Physical violence is never an option. I will not start or encourage a fight.
- There is a difference between tattling and telling an adult about something I've seen or heard that will put my well-being or the well-being of others in danger. I promise to tell an adult.
- I will remember that everyone is different. I will appreciate and respect those differences.
- 9. Remember to think BEFORE I act then:
 - I will be thoughtful and not bully or be aggressive toward others.
 - I will help those who are being bullied and not be a bystander [tell a teacher, write a statement, encourage those being bullied to tell, etc.]
 - I will be a reporter and tell an adult at school and home.
 - d. I will be an "includer" and make friends with students who seem left out.
- I will respect the learning environment by conducting myself in the commons as if I was in a library.
- I will respect others by keeping my hands off other people and off other people's property.
- I will help make 10th Street a positive learning environment for myself and everyone else.

All 10th Street Code of Conduct behavior expectations apply here, but in addition, please adhere to these following rules. These are for the safety and protection of all of our students.

Inside:

- 1. Follow the "Reduce, Reuse, & Recycle" rules that are posted.
- Be Respectful Treat every adult with the same respect as you do your teachers.
- Walk inside the building.
- Sit one student per seat (no lap sitting).
- 5. Sit only on the lunchroom benches (do not sit on floors or table tops).
- 6. Only go into the Gym area if an adult gives you permission.
- Stay in the Cafeteria area except to use the bathroom. Loitering in the bathroom or hallways is not allowed.
- 8. Students will be released from their tables in the cafeteria if;
 - A. Their area is clean
 - B. The students have followed all the rules
 - c. Supervision is available for outdoors
 - Stay between the Gym and 10th Street buildings.
 - Do not go past the tree line.
 - 3. Do not pick up, throw, or use sticks and rocks.
 - Do not climb on anything (stumps, fire hydrants, light poles, containers etc).
 - The parking lot, in front of the Gym, next to Heritage, and behind 10th Street's building are all off limits areas.
 - Must be within sight-line of the supervising adult.
 Disciplinary action may be taken if any of the above rules are violated.
