



VETERANS DAY ASSEMBLY

Columbia School District is proudly sponsoring a district-wide Veterans Day assembly on **November 9th at 9:30 a.m. at Columbia Central High School**. We want to have as many veterans as possible attend this event to honor them and teach our students about the importance of recognizing service to our country. Please invite a friend or relative and have them fill out the registration form below.

All veterans are invited to arrive **at the high school cafeteria at 9:00 a.m.** for a light breakfast reception. The assembly will include special music, poems and a reading of the veterans names and will last approximately one hour. If at all possible, please wear uniforms or other service/patriotic clothing.

For \$15, you can sponsor a flag. For each sponsorship, a 3'x5' American Flag on a 10' pole will be posted in front of the high school on Veterans Day to create a field of flags to honor those who are being celebrated. Ribbons will be tied to each pole to indicate branch of service and if the veteran is being honored in memoriam. This is a fundraiser organized by the Columbia Central High School Key Club and Jr. High School Builders Club for the Kids Against Hunger campaign which will be held in February. Students will be packing 10,000 meals for our local food pantry, the homeless and national disaster relief efforts.
