

DAYTON SCHOOL DISTRICT INTER-DISTRICT STUDENT TRANSFER REQUEST FORM AND AGREEMENT

(All requests for inter-district transfers must be originated with the resident district)

Criteria for Inter-district Transfers:

Policies of the above school district's Board of Directors establish the following four criteria as the basis for approving inter-district transfers of students.

- 1. When the student has completed the junior year in high school and wishes to continue in the school even though the student's family no longer resides within the district.
2. When the student is experiencing adjustment problems and the appropriate officials from both the resident and non-resident school districts believe that the student's problems can be alleviated by an inter-district transfer.
3. When the Educational Service District Superintendent has authorized an inter-district transfer to afford better educational facilities and effect a savings in the cost of education.
4. When attendance in the resident district would impose an undue hardship of a financial, educational, safety, or health nature upon the student or his/her parent(s) or other guardian or custodian.

In addition to the foregoing, any inter-district transfer must be in compliance with all other District policies including those relating to student attendance, academic standards, and class size.
