

CHEER LEADER UNIFORMS
Awarding of Student Apparel in Recognition of Outstanding Service

Students who participate in an extracurricular activity such as cheerleading sponsored by the Dayton School Associated Student Body provide leadership, encourage sportsmanship, and promote school recognition and school spirit within the school setting and community.

Each student may participate in the fundraising activities specifically designated for the purchase of the cheerleading uniforms. In addition the Dayton School Board recognizes each student will add personal contributions toward purchase of each uniform. Therefore, because of the unique situation and in recognition of these student's contribution and service, the Dayton Board of Directors authorizes uniforms and/or apparel used in the course of the service be awarded to the students at the honorable completion of such activities. These awards may be considered an intrinsic part of the cheerleading of the activity as long as the award is personal to the recipient, reasonable under the circumstances, and are not monetary awards.

Each award must have no greater than a minimal value and shall be submitted for approval to the Board of Directors prior to the transfer of ownership to the student at the second school board meeting in May.
