DRIVER EDUCATION APPLICATION INFORMATION

Please read the following information before completing the attached form!

There is a mandatory parent/guardian and student meeting at 7:00- 9:00 pm on Monday, May 23th, 2022!

1. Eligibility: Students must turn 15 years old on or before December 1st, 2022.
Fee: \$200 (Make checks payable to Alberton High School).
Paperwork: Completed application, a copy of birth certificate unless the school has one on file, student's SSN# and the program fee.
Due Date: Submit payment to the office or Mr. Johnson at the Parent/Student Meeting .
2. Students who drop the class or are removed from it will forfeit the fee.
3. Students must be punctual for all classes and appointed driving times.
4. Students missing more than two (2) classroom instruction days will be removed from the class, fail the course and forfeit the fee. Students must complete independent work assignments for any classroom lessons missed. If a student misses a scheduled drive time, it is at the discretion of the instructor whether that student will be removed from the program and his/her fee forfeited.
5. Do not schedule vacations or any other activities that will take you out of class for more than two (2) days.
6. Students will receive a total of sixty (60) hours of instruction:
 - a. 42 classroom hours
 - b. 12 in the car observation hours
 - c. 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction
7. No incompletes will be given. All work must be completed by the last day of instruction.
8. All students will be required to have an eye exam by the school nurse or other qualified personnel.
9. **At a time later TBD, an exit meeting must take place among the instructor, student, and parent/guardian before completing the class.**
