Purpose

The purpose of the OAASFEP scholarship program is to financially support postsecondary education for qualifying Ohio high school seniors who are planning to attend a college/university located in the state of Ohio for the fall semester.

Selection Process

Members of OAASFEP may recommend one candidate from their Ohio district/school for the OAASFEP state scholarship program.

Scholarship winners will be selected based on the following criteria (100 total points):

- Documentation of High School GPA (30 total points)
- Extracurricular activities/leadership activities within the community, school, or church (20 points)
- Three letters of recommendation, including letters from a principal or faculty member, an OAASFEP member, and a non-family member. (30 points)
- A 300 word (maximum) essay outlining his/her leadership activities and future goals (20 points)

The student's application and companion forms must be postmarked **on or before January 31st**.

Scholarship Payment

The full amount of the OAASFEP scholarship will be made payable to the awardee.

About The Scholarship

OAASFEP may offer up to four (4) scholarships each school year. The scholarship award is for a one-time payment of \$500.00. Those who are awarded an OAASFEP scholarship will be recognized at the upcoming OAASFEP Spring conference.
