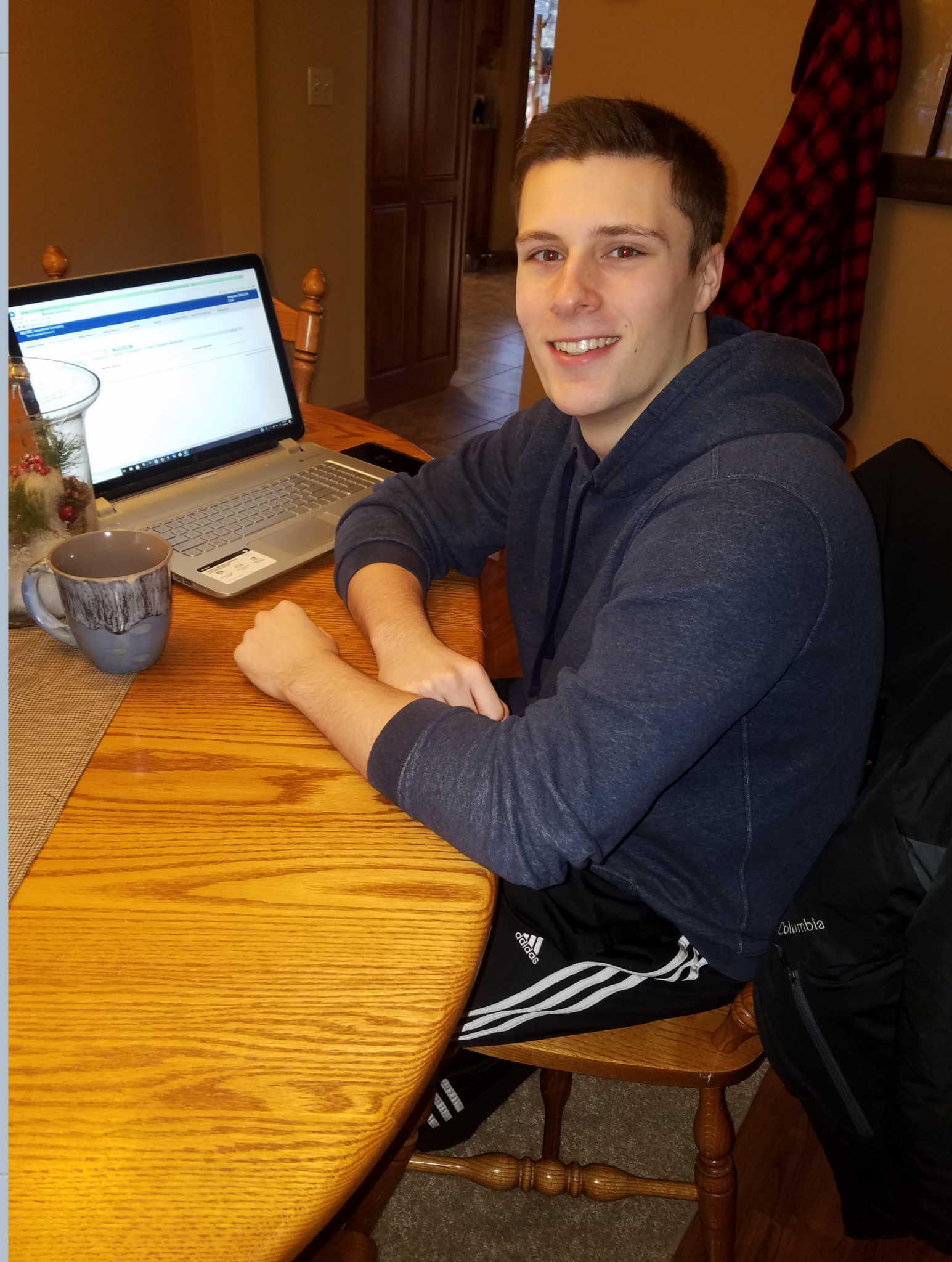

DEMOGRAPHICS AND COMMITMENT

- Work Based Learning Participation - 20 to 25 students, mostly morning and few afternoon, 4 GMCA students
- WBL positions are a school year commitment. Once the Training Agreement is signed, student is committed for the year.

PREREQUISITES AND LOGISTICS

- Student must have at least 17 credits entering their senior year
- Student must have at least a 2.0 GPA
- Student must have an established track record of excellent attendance
- Student must have their own reliable transportation
- Student must be willing to communicate with WBL Coordinator (email)
- Students are placed morning or afternoon
- Students will be evaluated twice a year
- WBL Coordinator will make regular site visits

ACADEMICS

- Students take at least 3 academic classes (3 credits) at BCHS
- In some situations the only opportunity to maintain WBL and enroll in necessary courses - a student may need to take a class online
- Students cannot participate in WBL AND Dual Enroll/BCEC. Only under individual, specific and exceptional circumstances would BCHS deviate from this policy
- Students must pass all classes with a C or better
- WBL is a pass/fail program. Pass = CR and fail = E. If you are fired or you quit, you will fail WBL. It is important to recognize that this may impact your GPA, graduation status, class ranking, and/or athletic eligibility.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS....

- Your Educational Development Plan (EDP) must be up to date
- Your Career Pathway must be up to date and accurate
- When scheduling, students must choose a WBL related class each semester
- You must check your email and our Google Classroom, this is how we communicate

SAFETY!

- Safety at all worksites is of paramount importance
- Students will only be placed at worksites that maintain up to date Worker's Compensation and Liability Insurance

PORTFOLIO

- Cover Letter
- Resume
- Letter of Recommendation(s)
- References (3 or more)
- Copy of Transcript
- Academic Awards, Certificates of Participation, Certification...

NEXT STEPS...

- Due Soon - portfolios and WBL Application should be submitted
- Mock Interview - March
- Updates and postings will be communicated via email (Google Classroom), this is a program requirement. If you do not use the school email system you cannot be a WBL student
- Interviews will begin in right away and can run all the way through summer
- Thank you letters, professional courtesy email

THIS IS A VERY FLUID PROCESS, THIS IS NOT A BUFFET, AND YOU ARE THE CHAMPION OF YOUR CAUSE....

- WBL students must be independent workers, self motivated, self driven, and good communicators.
- WBL placement just doesn't happen to you. You make it happen!
- Sometimes I have positions ready and available.
- Sometimes positions will fill right away and other times positions just flat go away.
- Sometimes new positions are created.
- Sometimes the student finds a part time/summer job and that can then turn into a WBL position.
- Sometimes what a student wants, isn't available and sometimes what an employer wants isn't available.
- If a position opens up and you are interested, you may want to apply right away, it may not be there tomorrow. Understand, this is a competitive process, just like any other job.

1. SIGN UP ON THE "INTERESTED STUDENTS" SHEET (PINK)
2. PICK UP, COMPLETE AND RETURN "PARENT/STUDENT ENROLLMENT" FORM (GREEN) AS WELL AS THE "APPLICATION FOR WORK BASED LEARNING" FORM (BLUE)
