## Distance Learning Virtual Field Trips at Sag Harbor Schools

## Past Distance Learning Field Trips:

* Mrs. Lattanzio's class last year went on a virtual field trip to the Perot Museum of Nature and Science in Texas for a program called Fire and Ice. They learned how matter changes when it is heated with extreme heat or cooled down with liquid nitrogen.
* Polar Bear Plunge- Last year Mrs. Driver's first grade learned about polar bears. Their field trip to the Polar Bear Plunge program was at the Saint Louis Zoo.
