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98c Learning Loss Plan

In September, we were notified that we would be eligible to receive 98c Learning Loss grants funds. At the time, the district decided to utilize the estimated \$23,000 to cover a portion of the salary of a recently hired reading interventionist in the early elementary. This was a new position for the 2022-2023 school year, and was created to achieve our MICIP goals for ELA Achievement. Our MICIP goals are posted as part of our district Learning Loss Plan.

Additionally, some concerns have arisen regarding student outcomes in math. Our district has seen a decline in post-pandemic middle school math proficiency as measured by the M-STEP and PSAT and college readiness as measured by the SAT. Therefore, we will be using 98c funds to pay to train three teachers in Math Recovery. Math Recovery includes an intensive professional learning program for teachers that provides math intervention and instruction to students at the elementary and secondary level. The training focuses on the foundational skills that are required for students to successfully master the content standards K-12. Additionally, the training would include the required instructional materials and potentially coaching sessions.
