Who...is Step-Up For?

- The Current Junior or Senior who strives to "Step-Up" and participate in college classes while at the high school level.
- Juniors and Seniors who meet eligibility criteria based on GPA, Current grades and behavioral record.
- Juniors And Seniors who want a challenge in their academic pursuit.

What ...is Step-Up?

- **Step-Up** is a program in which current High School Juniors and seniors have the opportunity to take up to 2 college classes, a semester, at the College of Southern Nevada, for **FREE** while they are in high school.
- It is a 1 year commitment of both Parents and Students.
- An opportunity to experience what college life is like while still having support from their high school teachers.


When...is Step-Up Offered?

- Step-Up is offered on a semester basis but is committed to on a yearly basis by both parents and students.
 - Ex: Student enters at the beginning of school year and remains in the program until the end of the school year.
 - Ex: Student enters in the Spring (second semester); and has the opportunity to continue in the summer; or following School Year, depending on Grade level (Seniors would only be eligible for 1 semester if entering during the Spring semester)

Where... is Step-Up Offered?

- Step-Up Classes can be taken online or at one of the 3 Major Colleges of Southern Nevada Campuses:
 - North Las Vegas Campus (Cheyenne and Van Der Meer St.)
 - Charleston Campus (Charleston and Community College Dr.)
 - Henderson Campus (College Dr.)
 - Online is an option!







Why...and how much does it cost?

- Step-Up is FREE!
- Transportation is not provided; however bus passes are given, as needed.
- Books and tuition are paid for by Step-Up.
- Special Supplies are also paid for by Step-Up.
 - EX: Cooking utensils for culinary classes
 - EX: Art supplies for art classes

FYI on Actual Cost without STEP-UP

- So how much would it cost if I didn't do Step-Up?
- 1 credit = \$128.25 (CSN tuition guide 2021-2022)
- Most classes are between 2-4 credits.
 - EX: ALS 101 = 3 credits ($$128.25 \times 3 = $384.75 \text{ NOT INCLUDING BOOKS}$)
 - EX: 2 classes @ max 4 credits each = 8 credits x \$128.25 = \$1,206 NOT INCLUDING BOOKS
 - 8 classes @ max 4 Credits each = 32 credits x \$128.25 = \$4,104 NOT INCLUDING BOOKS
- Books can cost between \$50-\$200 EACH

STEP-UP Deadlines

- Applications for SPRING 2023 Semester must be turned in by NOVEMBER 18, 2022!
- All late applications will be considered for the SUMMER/FALL 2023 Semester
- The registration Process does take about a month so please make sure you turn in your applications before the deadline!

I was Accepted! Now What?

- Students must register with The College of Southern Nevada to receive an NSHE number (student number)
- Students must take CSN Placement Exams
- Must Meet with an Academic advisor from CSN
- OFFICIALLY enroll in classes and submit class schedule to Ms.
 Mendez so we can pay for your classes and books!
- Everything must be completed before the last day we leave for Summer/Winter Break.
