

EARLY GRADUATION

All students in Regional School Unit 2 are required to meet the graduation requirements in RSU policy IKF before they are eligible to graduate from a RSU 2 school. This does not eliminate the possibility of students graduating before the “traditional” four years of high school.

At the time of request for early graduation, the student and parent/guardian shall conference with the Principal/designee and guidance counselor to discuss the request.

The student shall be awarded a high school diploma at the conclusion of their third year of high school (or before, if applicable) if all requirements are met and the student and parent/guardian fully approve at that time.

Students who enroll after the third year of high school in a college from which credits are transferred back to the high school are also eligible to receive a high school diploma after all requirements have been met. Prior to the conclusion of the 3rd year of high school (or before, if applicable), the student and parent/guardian shall notify the high school administration, in writing, that they wish the student to complete his/her high school requirements at a college where the student has been accepted. The student and parent/guardian shall confer with the Principal/designee and guidance counselor to agree on a course of study that shall fulfill high school requirements. On successful completion of courses, the student shall be awarded a high school diploma.
